

## HOTELS WITH A HIDDEN SECRET...



ISLABAJA-THE SECRET OF

The great house of the Marquesses of the "Quinta Roja" of the 16th century, nowadays the hotel of the same name, is one of the finest examples of the architecture of the island's Baroque peiod. It is situated in that group of buildings considered of most architectural interest in the "Villa y Puerto de Garachico" in the north of Tenerife, together with the old convent of the Order of St. Francis; the residence of the Counts of La Gomera; the Town Hall and St. Annes's Church.

At only 90 minutes fron Reina Sofia International airport, the Hotel is situated 100 meters of the quiet little beach of "El Muelle", and just only 10 minutes of the new Golf Course "Buenavista Golf", designed by Severiano Ballesteros, with free transfer & discounts in green fees.





The Hotel offer 20 splendid rooms, combined the rural style with the modern, meeting-room, bar-cafeteria (24h), Restaurant "El Alpendre, Tasca del Vino, Gifst shop, canarian patio, aljimez-living room, mountain bikes and a little spa (sauna, Jacuzzi & solarium).

A real find, this gorgeous little hotel stands in the heart of Garachico, Beautifully converted from a 17th century manor house, the **Quinta Roja** is built around a lovely galleried patio from which most of the rooms lead off. Whilst all modern conveniences have been added during the conversion, you still feel you are in an enchanting private home here with many original features combined with attentive service and a relaxing atmosphere.

There is a fine restaurant, a quaint little bar, rooftop jacuzzi/sun terrace as well as a fascinating souvenir shop selling all kinds of interesting local artefacts. Garachico itself is a charming seaside village, with cobbled streets, pretty squares many fine restaurants and an impressive cultural programme in keeping with its ancient history.

**J**ust 100 metres from the hotel is a public Olympic-size swimming pool and a tennis court. It is also an excellent base for exploring the beautiful Orotava region, Teide National Park or even driving over the mountains and down to Los Gigantes

Garachico is as far removed from the tourist resorts of the south as possible. It's not the place to stay if you want a hectic nightlife or a late-night kebab, but if you're looking to sample traditional Canarian cuisine, drink locally produced wine and go to bed with the sound of ocean waves rather than SClub7 in your ears,
